

Artifacts and Evidence

Evidence is the observed practice, products or results of a certificated classroom teacher's work that demonstrates the knowledge and skills of the educator with respect to the four-level rating system. This can also be a sample of student work that demonstrates student growth/skill development. (WAC 392-191A-030)

Artifacts are any products generated, developed or used by a certificated teacher. Artifacts should NOT be created specifically for the evaluation system. Additionally, tools or forms used in the evaluation process may be considered as artifacts.

Observations may be considered as artifacts with evidence.
